Meeting was done over Go To for the Press and Public

Rick Wilbur, Chairman opened Meeting at 9:10 a.m. following the Wyoming County Prison Board Meeting (Via: Go To Meeting).

Tom Henry moved to approve the April 21, 2020, Regular Meeting Minutes and the April 23, 2020 Work Session Meeting Minutes. Ernie King second the Motion. Motion carried.

Ernie King moved to approve and authorize the Chairman to sign the Waste Management Contract to collect trash at the Wyoming County Recycling Center. Tom Henry second the Motion. Motion carried.

Tom Henry moved to approve the date of July 11, 2020 as Electronic Recycling Day at the Wyoming County Recycling Center. Ernie King second the Motion. Motion carried.

Rick Wilbur moved to forward a Letter to Gov. Wolf requesting Wyoming County be moved from the Northeast District for the Coronavirus reopening Schedule to the Northcentral District. Both Rep. Bobach and Sen. Baker are in full Agreement with the reclassification request. Wyoming County low number of cases supports this request. Ernie King second the Motion. Motion carried.

Flo Kellett, Election Director discussed the progress in getting ready for the June 2, 2020 Elections. Flo reported Poll Workers will work and will not have to consolidate at this time.

The Commissioners reported on receiving additional CDBG funds in the amount of \$311,799.00 and sent a response that the County will accept the funds. No details on how the funds may be used.

Rick Wilbur moved to approve and sign the Lease with Hollowcrest as follows: 5-year Lease for the Agricultural Extension and District Justice at \$11.00 sq. ft. and 3-year Lease for Conservation District at \$11.00 sq. ft. Also Hollowcrest included at No charge a 1,200 sq. ft. space. Ernie King second the Motion. Motion carried.

Rick Wilbur also reported the Courthouse is still closed to outside visitors and employees will not be allowed in if they are not wearing a mask. Once in your work area it is up to you to wear a mask or not. Employees will also be required to have a temperature check and anyone over 100.7 degrees will not be admitted. Those between 99.0 degrees and 100.6 degrees will be required to wear a mask at all time or ask to leave if refused.
